### 📂 Event Overview

The BMSS Lipidomics SIG Meeting, a one-day conference on 8 July 2025, offered a compelling mix of technical innovation, cutting-edge research, and fostered community-building—truly a wonderful event for anyone involved in mass spectrometry-based lipidomics.

### Cutting-Edge Plenary Talks

- Professor Valerie O'Donnell (Cardiff University) opened with an illuminating lecture on 'How inflammation regulates the SARS-CoV-2 viral envelope', providing fresh insights into virus—host dynamics.
- Dr Matthew Conroy's Keynote (LIPID MAPS) showcased the vast utility of the LDIPI MAPSs databases and tools, underlining its role in driving global lipid research.
- In the second plenary Dr Cristina Legido-Quigley (King's College & Steno Diabetes Centre) explored the transformative potential of precision medicine via lipidomics, discussing multi-omic integration and machine learning in diagnostics for metabolic and neurological disorders.
- The concluding plenary by Prof. William Griffiths (Swansea University) focused on sterolomics, particularly on rare cholesterol-related disorders. Prof. Griffiths introduced a sterolomic library aimed at enhancing diagnosis and disease monitoring protocols

Complementing the plenaries, researchers presented on diverse topics. These sessions sparked vibrant discussions on methodology, instrumentation, and clinical translation.


