New CSS data added

We've added nearly 400 new entries to our Lipidomic Ion Mobility Database from Amie Solosky in Erin Baker's lab. These recent additions provide collision cross section (CCS) values for a library of oxylipins, offering an additional diagnostic tool for the identification of these biologically important molecules.
